Dear Applicant,

Since 2014, the Latino Resources Scholarship Fund has operated as a culturally responsive student success initiative providing support systems to students dedicated to achieving their college career goals. Investing in Latino students who demonstrate academic excellence, civic engagement, leadership and financial need reinforces Latino Resources mission of increasing Latino leadership through college completion and civic engagement.

The Latino Resources Scholarship Fund program is open to students who are pursuing college education goals at a community college, vocational school or university. Traditional and non-traditional students are invited to complete and submit their application by the May 31, 2017 deadline.

Please carefully read the information and instructions below. Only applicants who submit all information by the deadline are reviewed by the Latino Resources Scholarship Committee.

Terms

- Competitive scholarship awards are available for students enrolled in vocational, community college, undergraduate or graduate programs.
- The Latino Resources Scholarship Fund Committee may require additional information and/or a personal interview.
- Latino Resources Scholarship Fund recipients must be enrolled in an accredited institution within the United States at the time of disbursement of the award.
- All awards are made payable to the recipients and must be used for payment of tuition, books, educational supplies, student fees, room and board.
- Latino Resources Scholarship Fund students agree to actively participate at biannual Network Scholarship Luncheons.

Eligibility Requirements

- Applicants must meet the following conditions:
- Be a U.S. citizen, legal permanent resident or meet the criteria for DACA (Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals) approved students.
- Must have a permanent residence within Cook County, Illinois.
- Must be enrolled as a full-time student (12 or more credit hours) for Fall 2017 at a vocational school, community college, university or graduate school in a program that awards an associate's degree, bachelor's degree, master's/doctorate degree, certification or licensure.

Student Success Award Categories

- Vocational School/Community College (\$500 - \$1,000)
- Undergraduate/Graduate (\$1,000 - \$2,000)

Evaluation Criteria

- The student has a GPA of 3.50 or better on a 4.0 scale or equivalent, and, if the student is an entering freshman,
- The student scores 29 or higher on the ACT test, or 1350 or higher on the SAT test.

OR

- The student has a GPA of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale or equivalent, and, if the student is an entering freshman,
- The student scores 23 or higher on the ACT test, or 1100 or higher on the SAT test.

Exclusion Policy

An applicant is not eligible for the Latino Resources Scholarship Fund if:

- He/she is a relative (i.e., child, sister, brother, mother, father, grandparent, granddaughter, grandson, cousin, niece, nephew, brother-in-law, sister-in-law, step-relative) of the Latino Resources Scholarship Committee, Latino Resources Board of Directors to include the Executive Director and staff, or a donor of the scholarship program.
